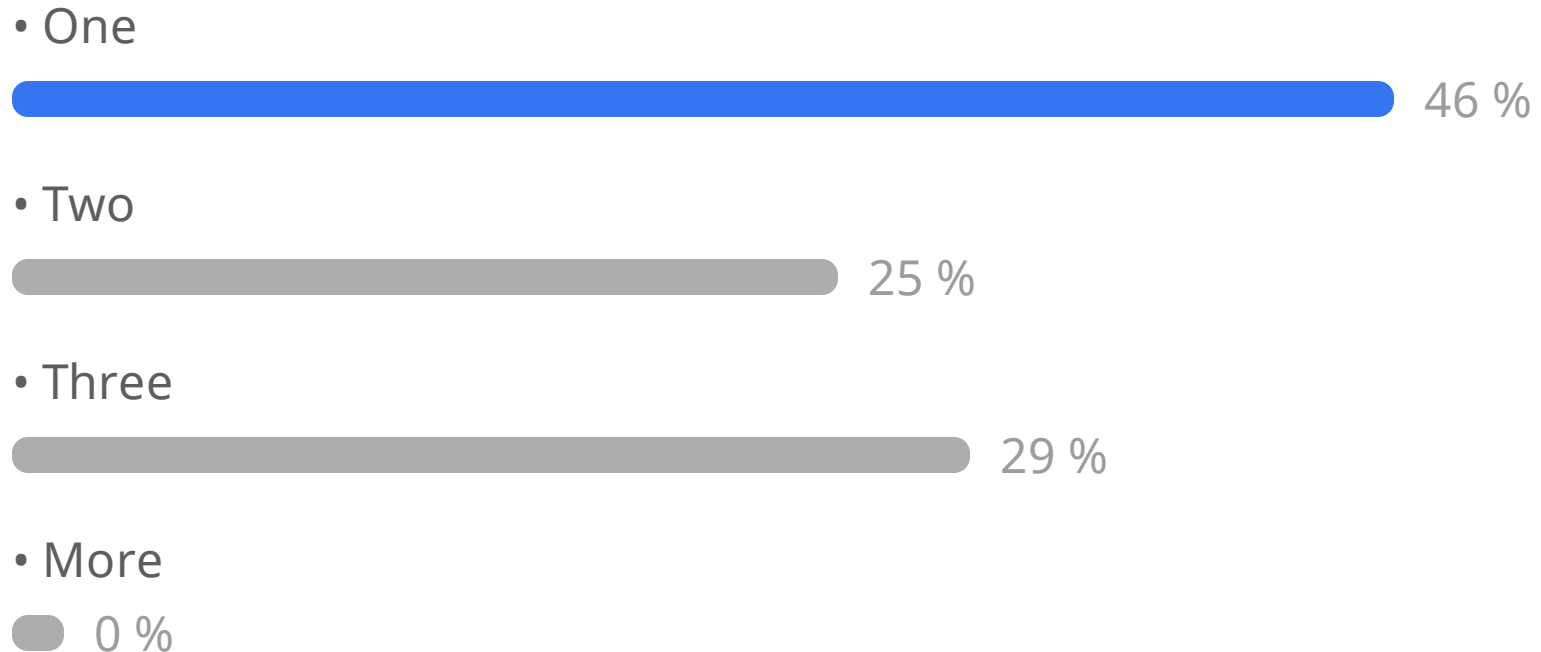

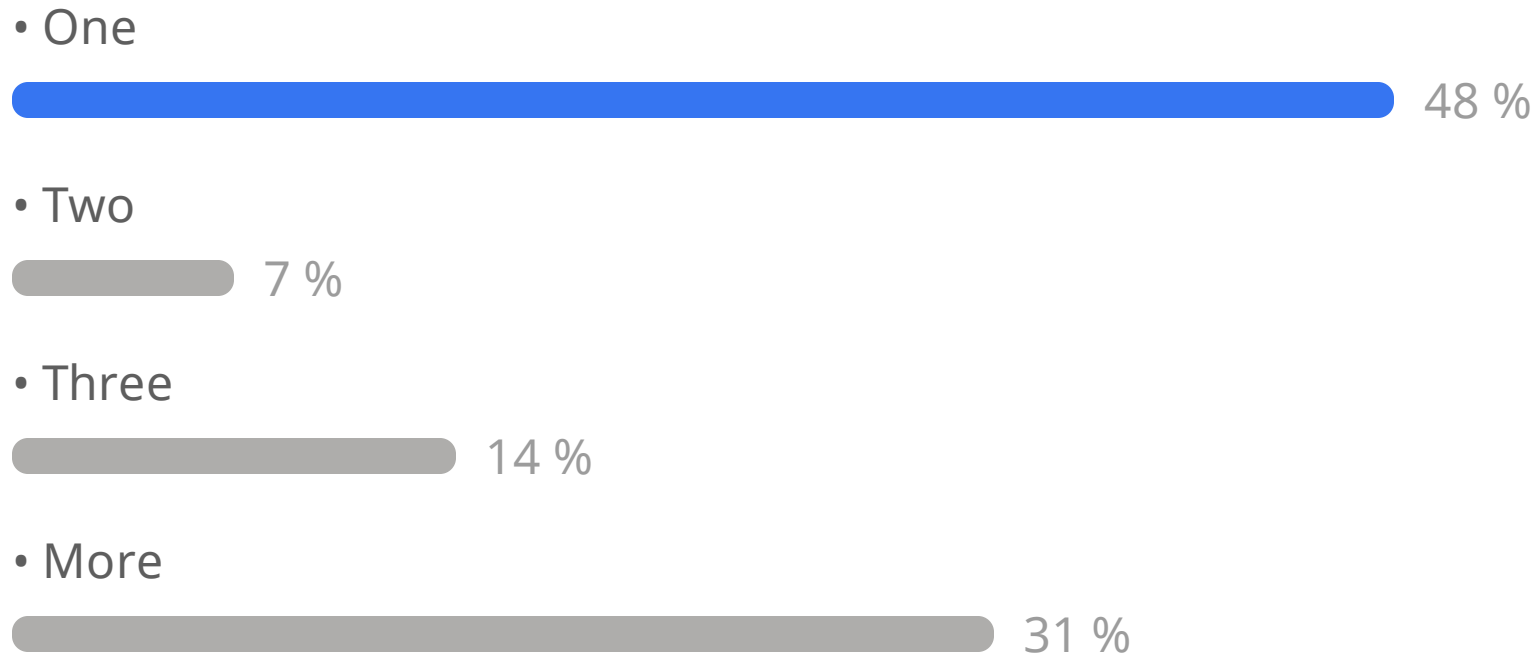
How many competent authorities have been involved in EU Timber Regulation implementation in your member state?
